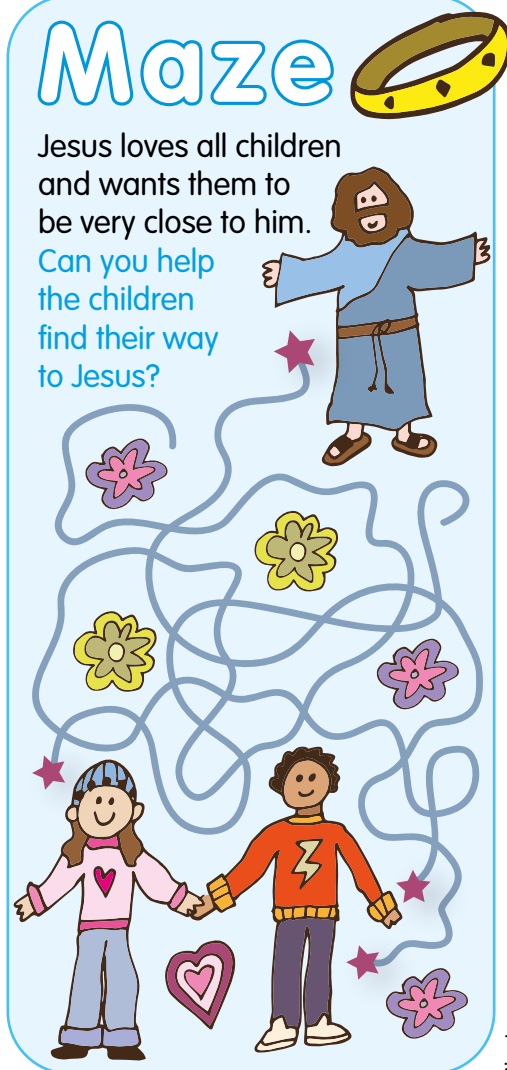
People who are married wear a ring. A ring has no ending. It shows that love goes on forever. Can you find the 4 lost wedding rings on this page?

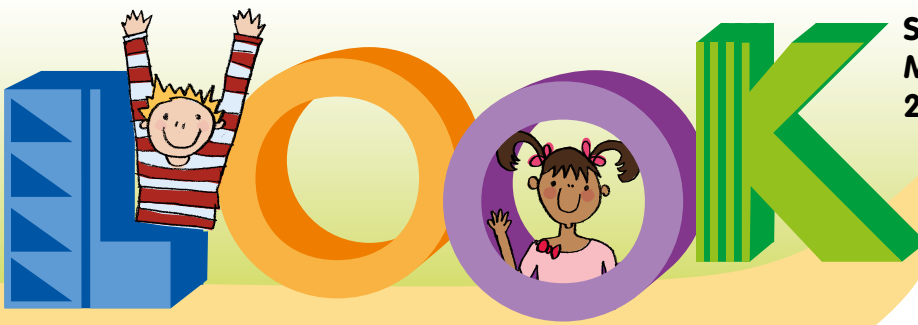
Jesus loves all children and wants them to be very close to him.

He doesn't think he can share all his money.

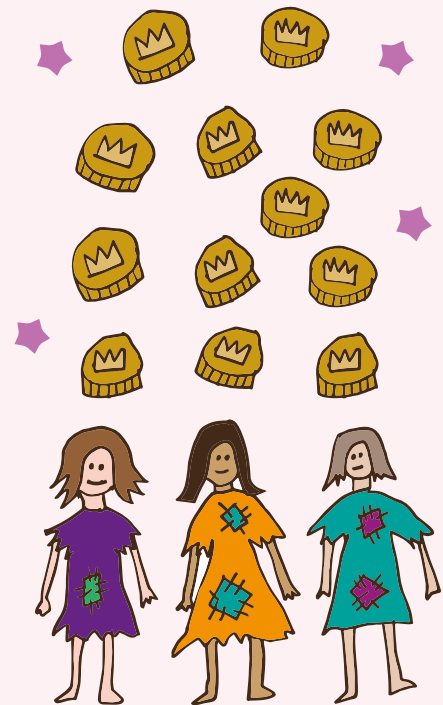


IN THE GOSPEL TODAY

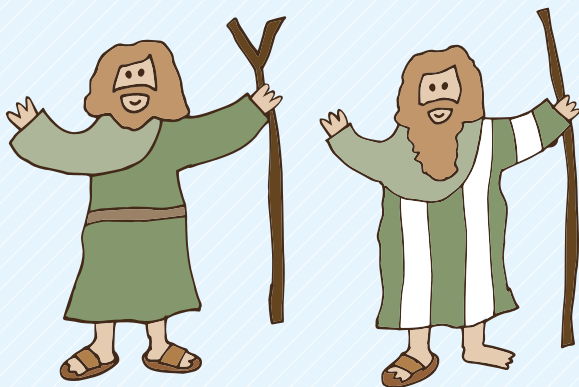

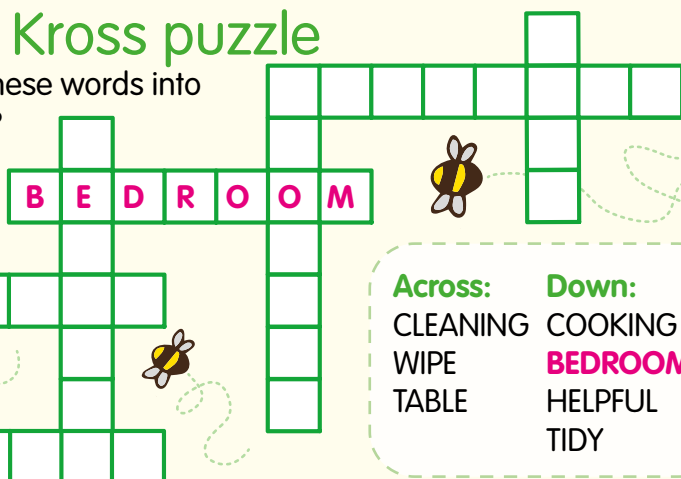

Maze

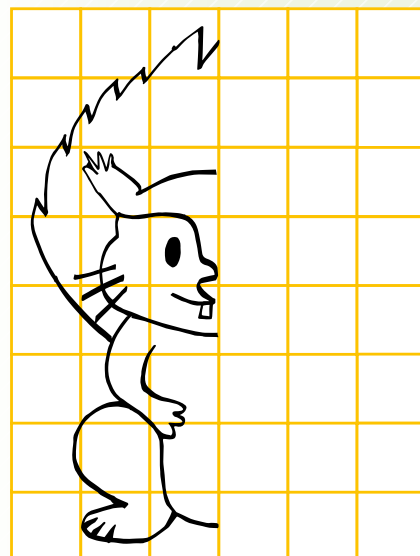
After he was healed Bartimaeus followed Jesus along the road. Help Bartimaeus follow Jesus along the path to eternal life.

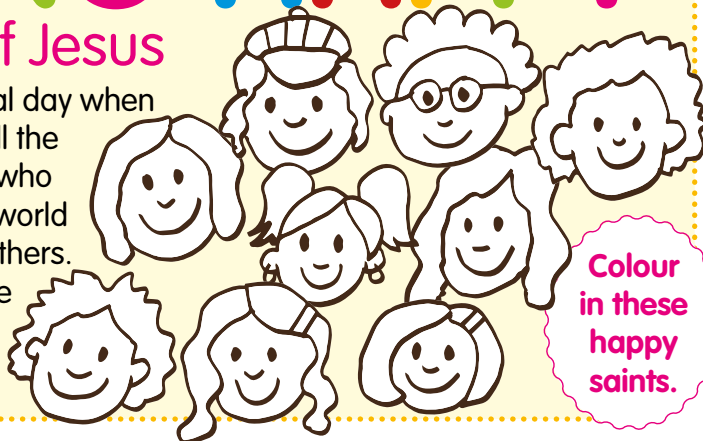
IN THE GOSPEL TODAY

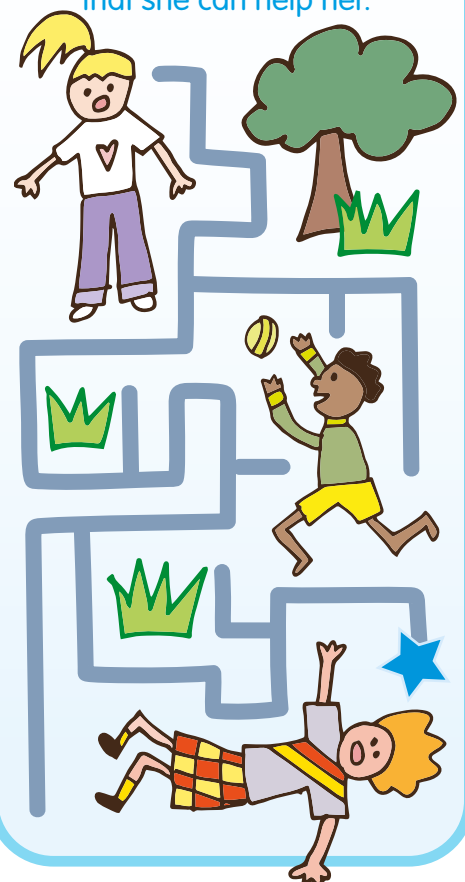

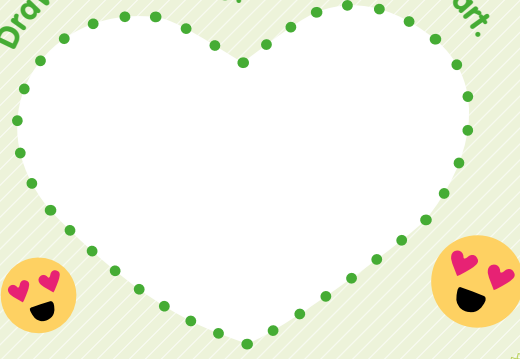

Following God's commandments

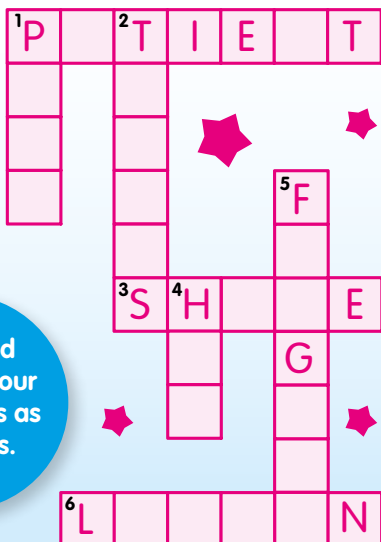
