Director Ai Weiwei artfully captures the massive and shocking breadth of the global migration crisis in this epic multi-award winning film, which portrays the plight of today's near 80 million forcibly displaced individuals – the highest number ever and growing – forced out of their homes by war, famine and climate change on long, treacherous journeys in search of new lives.

Filmed over the span of a year, Human Flow was shot by 25 film crews in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, France, Greece, Germany, Hungary, Iraq, Israel, Italy, Jordan, Kenya, Lebanon, Macedonia, Malaysia, Mexico, Pakistan, Palestine, Serbia, Switzerland, Syria, Thailand, and Turkey.
